HWY 97T merges back in N HWY 97 just north of Sand Springs.

TEST INFORMATION

TEST LIMITED TO 4 TD & 4 TDX ENTRIES

- **Closing Date: Tuesday, April 13, 2010, 5:00 PM CST, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted.**
- **Entry fee: TD, \$50.00, TDX, \$100.00, (includes AKC Recording and Service Fees). Fees must be paid in U.S. funds. Make checks payable to: Indian Nations Tracking Club.**
- Regardless of entry limits, all entries will be accepted until the official closing date & time. *A drawing will be held on Tuesday, April 13, 2010 at 6:00 PM at the Tulsa Garden Center, 2435 S. Peoria Ave., Tulsa, OK 74114.* The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, except that preference will be given those dogs who have not received Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Excellent titles. Once entries have been drawn, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The Secretary will notify entrants and alternates will be given the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those alternates that do not decline immediately will be placed on the alternate list in the order in which they were drawn. The alternates will be asked to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Assuming all tracks are filled, alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees. INTC will also refund fees to any confirmed entry who withdraws from the test provided that the Test Secretary

is notified prior to the date of the test, **and** provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

- If the limit for entries is not reached in one test, and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged up to the day of plotting. The following substitution factor will be in effect, 2TDs=1 TDX.
- **CERTIFICATION:** Each TD entry must be accompanied by an original certification issued by an AKC Tracking Judge. Dogs that possess the title of TD are exempt from this provision.

- Acknowledgement will be emailed/mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries.
- **All dogs/handlers should be at John Zink Ranch pavilion, 7798 John Zink Rd. by 8:00 AM. At 8:15 AM, Sunday, May 2, 2010, the draw for running tracks for all dogs entered will begin.** The first track will be run as soon thereafter as aging and conditions apply. In the event of any absentees among confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.
- Bitches in season may participate subject to the provisions set forth in the latest issue of the AKC Tracking Regulations.
- By their presence on the Test grounds, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by the AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Committee to the best of their ability. The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at their own risk.
- **DOGS SHALL BE KEPT ON LEAD AT ALL TIMES IN ANY AREA OF THE TEST SITE.**
